## HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES & NEW ORGANISMS ACT 1996 (HSNO)



It's worth remembering that there is already legislation in place that duty holders should be complying with. Hazardous substances are currently regulated under HSNO which aims to protect the environment and the health and safety of people from the adverse effects of hazardous substances. HSNO is largely implemented by the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA). The workplace requirements are currently enforced by WorkSafe.

## THE HEALTH AND SAFETY AT WORK ACT 2015 (HSWA)

HSWA and its first phase of supporting regulations came into force in April 2016. It aims to protect people against harm to their health, safety and welfare caused by risks arising from work. HSWA is primarily administered and enforced by WorkSafe.

The rules around managing hazardous substances that affect human health and safety in the workplace will be transferred from HSNO to the Hazardous Substances Regulations under HSWA. The rules and duties to mitigate risks posed by hazardous substances will sit under:
